Seven file for District 622 School Board

Seven residents have filed for School Board in the North St. Paul-Maplewood-Oakdale School District. The candidates are: Theresa Auge', Richard Bennett, Crystal Coleman, Steve Hunt, Nancy Livingston, Becky Neve and Danny Porter.

The North St. Paul-Maplewood-Oakdale School District will hold a general election on Nov. 8, 2016 for the purpose of electing four school Board members for terms of four years each.

The filing period for candidates closed on Aug. 16, 2016. The four seats up for election are currently held by Theresa Auge', Steve Hunt, Nancy Livingston and Becky Neve.

Candidates for School Board must be an eligible voter, must be at least 21 years of age before assuming office, must have been a resident of the School District for at least 30 days before the general election, have not been convicted of an offense for which registration is required under Minn. Stat. 243.166 and must have no other affidavit on file for any other office.

The general election will be held between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Tuesday, Nov. 8. Visit <http://pollfinder.sos.state.mn.us/> to find your polling place. Candidate filing information is also available at: <http://candidates.sos.state.mn.us/>.


