**REGULAR MEETING
SCHOOL BOARD
April 24, 2007**

Chair Miller called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. with the following present: Chair Miller, Vice Chair Livingston, Treasurer Cove, Clerk Wheeler, Directors Augé, Cunningham, Duddeck, Superintendent Phillips, Student Representative Andy Doran. Absent: Student Representative Robyn Duke.

Others present were: Bob Biddick, Director of Technology; Keith Gray, Director of Human Resources; Dennis Sullivan, Director of Business Services; Maureen Larson, Director of Community Education; Lorie Schulstad-Werk, Director of Special Services; Gene Janicke, Director of Teaching and Learning; and Kim Cavallaro, Administrative Assistant.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Miller introduced Megan Mallory, a sophomore at Tartan High School, who will serve as Tartan's 2007-08 Student Representative to the Board.

Livingston moved and Wheeler seconded the following motion, which carried:

THAT the agenda be approved as presented.

Augé presented the following Achievement Awards: A)Oakdale Physical Education Teacher Kirsten Eckberg for her efforts with Oakdale Elementary's Jump Rope for Heart program, B)Teachers/TOSAs/Coaches Laura Cochlin, Stacie Stanley, Bridget Bruner, Karen Hyers, Judy Rohde for coordinating and authoring math questions for the Pioneer Press's MCA student study guide, C)2nd grade Skyview Elementary student Emily Koithan whose story was selected as a Pioneer Press Merit Finalist, D) Bus Monitor Carol Schumacher for engaging her students with books and flashcards on the Skyview Elementary bus that she works on.

During the Public Comment section of the meeting, Mary Tomes addressed the Board with concerns about the Proposed Teacher Unrequested Leave of Absence & Non-renewal of Probationary Teachers. Craig Lindsay addressed the Board with concerns about the Calendar.

Duddeck moved and Livingston seconded the following resolution, which carried:

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Independent School District No. 622 that the following Consent Agenda Items, V.A. through V.F., be approved as written, and a copy of the agenda items is attached to the minutes.

Phillips introduced Cathy Seehuetter from Compassionate Friends, employee Marsha Williams and her husband Russ. Marsha and Russ nominated District 622 to be recognized as a Compassionate Employer. Marsha Williams submitted her nomination of District 622 in conjunction with the way she was treated during the sickness and eventual death of her son. Williams read her nomination letter to the Board and Seehuetter presented the district with an award. Miller thanked Marsha and Russ for nominating District 622 and also thanked the district for taking care of the needs of their employees as they work through difficult times.

The board recessed 7:25 – 7:33 p.m. Upon reconvening, Janicke presented the March 30, 2007 Enrollment Report.

Biddick presented the 2007-2011 Technology Plan and reviewed the planning process from Winter of 2006 up to May 2007, when the plan will be sent to MDE for certification. He identified strengths and needs and discussed how the Action Plans for 2007-2011 are based on assessment data, state mandates, strategic plan and known technological limitations. Biddick listed the following goals: Goal #1) Student & Staff Access, Goal #2) External Access, Goal #3) Internal Access, Goal #4) Technology Support, Goal #5) Technology Finances, Goal #6) Communications, Goal #7) Leadership, Goal #8) Assistive Technology and Universal Design for Learning, Goal #9) Staff Development, Goal #10) Instructional Technology, Goal #11) Data Assessment.

Sullivan reported on the referendum discussion that was held at the April 10, 2007 Board Study Session. Four Fall 2007 referendum simulations were compared, showing referendum and equity amounts, net revenue gain and revenue difference. The tax impacts for each of the scenarios were also considered. Revenue and expenditure projection assumptions were reviewed. The need for additional funding is there, but not knowing what our legislative funding will be, the majority of the board feels that the community does not wish the district to pursue a levy for the coming year.

Sullivan summarized the presentation that was given at the April 10, 2007 Study Session on the Maplewood MnDOT proposed bus garage site at Highways 5 & 120. Discussion at the Study Session indicated that the district discontinue pursuing the site and instead investigate other options. District next steps would include the setup of a committee to investigate our needs and financing options.



Augé moved and Cunningham seconded the following motion, which carried:

THAT the Board would have a Closed Session immediately after adjournment of the meeting for the purpose of discussing negotiations.

During Board Communications, the following items were shared:

- ✓ Doran mentioned the recent play at North High and that it was wonderful. He stated that St. Mark's is featuring "Joseph" and invited everyone to attend.
- ✓ Cunningham said that the Sta²rs Banquet would be held on May 2. This banquet recognizes the top 10% of students at North and Tartan.
- ✓ Livingston invited the audience to attend "Pollyanna", the Tartan play, which will be held over the next two weekends.
- ✓ Duddeck stated that the major construction on Highway 36 will begin on May 1. He discussed "Detour Days" – special events that will be held in North St. Paul this Friday and Saturday. He mentioned that the City of North St. Paul will have special signage placed in crosswalks during the construction period. Duddeck also discussed the implementation of the 800 megahertz radio system that will take place on June 20.
- ✓ Augé shared that the 622 Education Foundation Variety Show was a great success and that Janicke was the host for the event. She

mentioned that there are a lot of events happening in the schools – Relay for Life and the Yellow Ribbon program. She also gave an update on the St. Paul EMID board representative.

- ✓ Cove extended an invitation to everyone to attend the OBPA monthly meeting on May 3 and said that 5 or 6 scholarships would be given out at this meeting. He stated that the OBPA Gold Plate Dinner was on May 7 and that this event would raise money to help fund scholarships.
- ✓ Miller mentioned that the Polar Den is located in the North St. Paul Community Center and it is run by the DECA students at North High. She thanked the teachers, students, staff, the City of North St. Paul, and Scott Duddeck for all of their help and hard work with the Polar Den.
