GED Preparation Classes

General Education Development (GED) Preparation is a self-paced program designed to help you study and prepare to take the GED tests. Day or evening drop-in classroom training is available at no cost to adults in our community. Our staff will work with you on the subjects in which you need improvement. Practice tests help monitor your progress and prepare you for taking the official GED tests. Come when you can—you don't have to attend the entire time! The time needed to complete the GED varies for each student. *Tuesday–Thursday 9:00 am–8:00 pm*

Pre-GED Classes

If you're a little rusty, we'll work to help you improve your reading and math skills to a level necessary for the GED preparation class. *Tuesday–Thursday 5:00–8:00 pm*

Accuplacer Class

The ACCUPLACER college admission test is used to help determine course selection for students and includes reading comprehension, sentence skills and math. *Tuesday–Thursday 9:00 am–8:00 pm*

Register for a Class

Registration takes 1–2 ½ hours and must be done in person at Harmony Learning Center. Students may register during the following hours:

- Monday–Thursday 9:00 am–8:00 pm
- Friday 9:00 am–2:00 pm

Testing may be scheduled at Harmony Learning Center.
Monday–Thursday 9:15 am–7:30 pm
Fridays between 9:15 am–1:30 pm
The fee is \$30 per test. The total cost for all four tests is \$120. The GED tests may be taken in any order.

GED Requirements in Minnesota

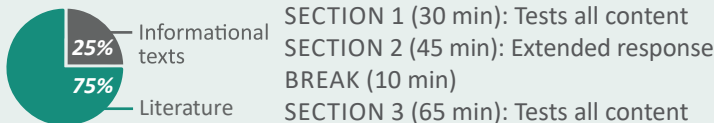
- Haven't graduated from high school and not currently enrolled in high school
- At least 19 years of age or an age waiver*
- Minnesota resident
- Bring two of the following: Minnesota driver's license, passport or State ID card with picture, date and place of residence

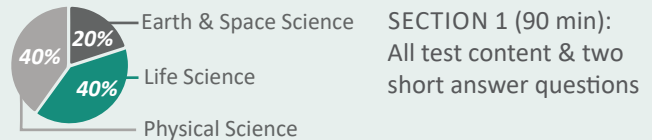
What are the GED Tests?

The GED tests are four tests in the areas of Reasoning through Language Arts (RLA) , Social Studies, Science and Math.

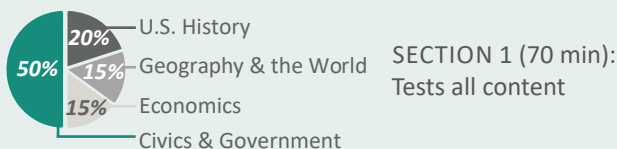
REASONING THROUGH LANGUAGE ARTS (RLA) | 150 minutes
