Registration & Account Management

- Registration and account changes are made online at www.isd622.ce.eleyo.com
- Invoices are generated on the 15th of each month and payment is due on the last day of the month.
- Schedule changes require one week notice and there is a \$15 fee. Withdrawals require a two week notice with no fee.
- Drop in care: Drop in care is available for all currently enrolled students with a 24 hour notice. Drop in care is billed at the end of the month and requires a debit/credit card on file.
- MCCAP (Minnesota County Childcare Assistance Program) is accepted. Authorization from the county must be received before you can start.
