

Commercial Driver's License

Description:

This course will provide students with the knowledge necessary to pass the Federal and State of Minnesota Commercial Driver's License Permit.

- General knowledge test
- Air brake test
- Combination vehicle test
- Pre-trip vehicle inspection test
- Transporting passengers safety test
- School bus endorsement test

Requirements: Students should be able to do the following:

- 12 week commitment
- CASAS Reading test score of 221+ or TABE D Reading test score of 5.0+
- Valid driver's license with a clean driving record
- No DWI's, no speeding tickets in the last five years. No accidents in the last three years
- 21 years of age
- Ability to sit for long periods of time

Application Process: This course is offered twice a year. Enrollment is done on a walk in basis, no appointment needed. Registration takes place on Monday and Wednesdays.

Next Steps:

Once done with the course, students will need to take the behind the wheel training to complete their CDL. This training can be completed at [Century College](#) or [Dakota County Technical College](#). There are also independent companies that will provide the behind the wheel training once hired.
