

Construction Training

Description:

Is a 12-week course designed to provide job skills for a career in construction and related trades.

The 300 hour training course incorporates:

- 25 hours of weekly classroom, shop, and site training
- Six weeks paid training on construction sites
- Instruction in construction concepts, green building practices, tool use, blueprints, math and measuring, insulation, drywall, siding, roofing and deconstruction
- OSHA 10 Certification
- Lead Abatement Worker Certification
- Union and construction industry speakers/tours

Application Process: Potential applicants must attend an information session the Second and Fourth Tuesday of every month (this month's schedule is below), held at 1:45 p.m.
