

GOODWILL EASTER SEALS PROGRAM

Description: Organization that provides employment and support services throughout the state. Areas that they support include;

- Industry-specific job skills training
- Transitional employment services
- Job development and placement services
- Job coaching and follow-up services
- Mental health clinic and Adult Rehabilitative Mental Health Services (ARMHS)
- GED tutoring (primarily through the FATHER Project)
- Medical Equipment Loan
- Parenting support groups (primarily through the FATHER Project)
- Connections to other community resources
- Workshops and individual job search assistance in our communities conducted at schools, libraries and community centers.

Who is Eligible: You may qualify if you are facing barriers to employment, such as:

- Chronic unemployment
- Dislocated workers
- Recent incarceration
- Lack of education
- Refugee or recent immigrant
- Low-income fathers
- Non-native English speaker
- Alcohol or chemical dependency issues
- Homelessness
- At-risk youth or other at-risk individuals
- Physical or mental disabilities

Application Process: To ask about services from Goodwill-Easter Seals Minnesota and to see if you qualify, follow these steps.

1. Go to the Goodwill website and Click on Employment & Training
2. Select the program which you believe will best meet your needs at right.
3. Click the underlined text.
4. Complete the form and click "Submit."
5. Your inquiry will be sent to the intake coordinator.
6. The intake coordinator will call to arrange an intake interview to determine if you qualify for this program or another one.
