Description: A no cost government education and career training facility. It provides advancement in education, career training, as well as dorms and recreational facilities. Career training and education can include:

- Business Technology
- Facilities Maintenance
- Food Services
- Health Occupations
- Medical Office Support
- Painting/Wallpapering
- GED courses
- Potential to go to college if you have been there for 6 months or more

Students are paid a living allowance and given three meals a day. Once student graduate, they are given a transition allowance of up to \$1,000, job placement assistance for up to 9 months, career and relocation counseling.

Who is Eligible: 16-24 year olds who do not engage in chemical use or violent acts of crime.
