Description: - MRC offers services in the areas of Assessment, Accredited Career Skills Training, Job Placement, and Job Retention. MRC offers services that help participants assess their skills and skill potential, expand and enhance technical and interpersonal skills through career skills training, secure employment through individualized placement, and retain and maintain their jobs through intensive post-placement follow-along services. Services can last from a few days to many months.

Who is Eligible: People with physical, sensory, mental health and other disabilities, immigrants and refugees, and individuals transitioning off of public assistance. Specifically for individuals with barriers to competitive employment. MRC services must be paid by VRS or the business that refers the individual.

Application Process: A referring counselor from VRS or a business that would like to train its employees must refer an individual to MRC. The MRC Referral Form must be completed and mailed or faxed to MRC, along with documentation of an individual's disability, when applicable. Once the referral form is received, an MRC staff person will call the individual and referring counselor to schedule an intake appointment.
