

OCCUPATIONAL PREP COURSES at HUBBS

Construction Training

Description:

Students are given hands-on skills to enter Pre-Apprenticeship programs with the building trades. Students will enhance their carpentry math and reading skills. They will develop skills in the use of hand and power tools. Learn skills in construction safety and material handling

Requirements:

- 10 week commitment
- TABE D Reading Test score of 6.0-12.5, TABE D Math 5.0+
- Ability to lift 60 or more pounds
- Ability to bend, squat, and climb ladders
- Ability to work in harsh climates/conditions

Application Process: This course is offered once a year. Enrollment is done on a walk in basis, no appointment needed. Registration takes place on Monday and Wednesdays.

Next Steps:

Students that complete the 10 week class will have an option to apply for a pre-apprenticeship training program with the Trades Unions, continue their training through community service programs, community college or move into employment
