

ServSafe® Food Safety Class

Description:

The Minnesota Department of Health requires most food service establishments to have a certified food professional on staff at all times. This course fulfills and meets the food manager certification requirements for the State of Minnesota. ServSafe training prepares you to deal with food borne illness, minimizes insurance costs, reduces liability and improves food quality.

This class is for you if:

- Currently working in food service and want a promotion
- Want a credential to enter and move up in the food service industry

Requirements: Students must have the following:

- 12 week commitment
- CASAS Reading test score of 226+
- TABE D Reading test score of 6.0-12.5

Schedule: This course is offered once a year. Registration is open Mondays and Wednesdays.

Next Steps:

Once done with the class, students have the option of taking the ServSafe® Exam, which is administered at the Hubbs Center. There is a \$40.00 exam fee. Once the learner has passed the exam they can apply for the Minnesota Certified Food Manager license, a \$35.00 fee.
