

Special Low Pressure Boiler License Course

Description:

This course leads to a state special license, which is the first step needed to operate or tend to low pressure stationary steam boilers and auxiliary steam equipment, such as pumps, compressors and air conditioning equipment. Careers include; Janitorial, Building Maintenance or Apartment Caretaker positions.

Requirements: Students must have the following:

- CASAS Reading test score of 236+
- TABE D Reading test score of 6.0+
- 12 week commitment
- High School Diploma or GED
- Ability to lift 60+ pounds
- Ability to bend, squat, and climb ladders

Application Process: This course is offered once a year. Registration is open once a year.

Next Steps: Individuals that are ready will be able to take their Boiler's license through Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry. Once they have passed their test individuals can look into apprenticeships.
