VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION SERVICES (VRS)

Description: - A government organization that is connected to the Workforce Center, the specifically works with individuals with disabilities. Once you are eligible you are set up with a VRS worker who works with you on developing a goal towards employment or training. The counselor can support you in making a resume, cover letter, applying for jobs, some financial support for college or training, and providing a short term job coach on the job, if needed. You can also go to the Workforce Center to access their computers.

Who is Eligible: Individuals whose disability is a barrier to their employment. This is a free service. Some services may cost money and you may pay on a sliding scale.

Application Process: You must have proof of a physical or mental condition (IEP or evaluation from school) and evidence that your disability makes it hard to get or keep employment. You will complete a paper application and will need your personal information, social security number, household yearly income, and information on how your disability affects you.
