## Polars Basketball Camp and Alumni Game



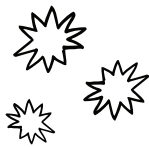

## Baton Twirling Fundamentals

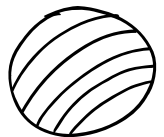

Grades 6–8

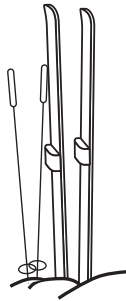
