



North St. Paul - Maplewood - Oakdale School District 622 residents will be asked to renew a no tax increase operating levy and asked to add a capital projects levy for the purpose of funding classroom technology and curriculum.

Question 1 is a no tax increase renewal of an existing operating levy passed in 2011. It maintains funding that is already in place.

Question 2 is a \$3 million classroom technology and curriculum capital projects levy. It will fulfill *classroom needs* such as:

- Digital curriculum and classroom tools
- Replacement cycle for more than 10,000 district devices
- Technology staff
- Technology infrastructure

If Question 1 doesn't pass:

- Increased class sizes
- Reduced number of receptionists, academic support staff, and lunchroom/recess monitors
- Reduced advanced learning opportunities
- Reduced activity bus routes
- Reduced mental health support staff

If Question 2 doesn't pass:

- Missed curriculum opportunities for students
- Devices will not have a replacement cycle when they become broken or outdated
- Understaffed technology department
