PARKING POLICIES, PROCEDURES, AND REGULATIONS.

It is the responsibility of the student to be aware of the following regulations and abide by them:

- All vehicles must have a parking permit to park on school property. Permits should be hung on rear view mirror facing outward.
- Students are not allowed to go their car during the day without a pass or permission from the Main Office.
- Students are NOT to park in numbered, reserved, or visitor parking.
- All vehicles must be parked orderly in-between painted lines.
- Students must exercise caution at all times. Students must not drive faster than 10 mph and must yield to pedestrians, and obey all traffic laws.
- School District 622 is not responsible for vandalism, theft, or injury in the school parking lot. Valuables should not be left in cars. Drivers should lock vehicles when leaving them parked in school lots.
- Students who violate parking regulations or school policies (i.e. truancy) will be subject to disciplinary consequences and possible permit revocation for part or all of the school year. Consequences could result in fines, towing, vehicle immobilization. Cost for removal of immobilization device is \$25.00
- All vehicles parked on school property are subject to being searched. Refusal to comply with search request will result in disciplinary action including, but not limited to, suspension, expulsion, or loss of parking privileges.
- Permits are NOT transferable. Students may not lend or resell their permit to other students.
- Any students involved in using, making, or distributing forged parking permits will be referred to the police for prosecution. In addition, school consequences may include suspension, loss of parking permit privileges without refund, or other consequences deemed appropriate.
