Thank you School District 622 voters! With all precincts reporting, our November 2016 levy increase request passed with 54.5% yes (22,081 votes) to 45.5% no (18,409 votes) *. Learn more www.isd622.org/electionresults2016.

Residents elect four to School Board

Voters in the North St. Paul-Maplewood-Oakdale School District have elected four incumbents to serve on the School Board. Incumbents Theresa Auge', Nancy Livingston, Steve Hunt and Becky Neve were elected to serve four-year terms on the Board. The terms for the four seats up for election expire on Dec. 31, 2016.
