Back to School Immunization Clinics

School District 622, in partnership with Homeland Health, will hold two immunization clinics for enrolled District 622 students only who have not received their required shots prior to starting school.

Students must bring their Student Immunization Form to the clinic, which specifies the immunizations he or she needs prior to starting school. The Form is available from the health office at each school or online at www.isd622.org/immunizations. Immunizations will not be given without this form.

A \$14 administrative fee is requested per vaccination, but no one will be turned away for inability to pay. Families with insurance should bring their insurance card with them. To make it easier for staff to give the vaccinations it is suggested that students wear short sleeves.

The immunization clinics will be held at the District Education Center, 2520 12th Avenue East, North St. Paul on the following dates and times:

- Tuesday, Sept. 6 – 8am to noon
- Wednesday, Sept. 7 – 8am to noon
