

622 Advisory Committee

Purpose: The District 622 Advisory Committee serves to convey community beliefs and opinions as they relate to curriculum issues. The committee is composed of parents, teachers, administrators, and community members who will participate in a process to review and improve instruction, curriculum, and assessment in District 622. Being a member of the 622 Advisory Committee provides an opportunity to advise the school board on the implementation of the state and local graduation requirements. 622 Advisory members serve as a sounding board for the community, gain knowledge about the district's curricula and its development, and to positively influence change within each curriculum area based on knowledge, research, and community needs.

Responsibilities:

- Attend monthly meetings from September through May (additional meetings may be scheduled by membership, as needed)
 - **6:00-8:00 PM at the District Education Center**
 - **Meetings for 2016-2017 School Year:** September 13, October 4, November 1, December 6, January 10, February 7, March 7, April 4, May 2
- Review the school district instructional and curriculum plan, with emphasis on implementing the Minnesota Academic Standards and Graduation requirements.
- Provide feedback to the implementation of the school district system accountability and comprehensive continuous improvement process

Application:

- Application process identified in the District 622 Annual Report on Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment each year.
- Building representatives are nominated by their school's parent organization and determined by the building principal.
- Community representatives apply to the District 622 Curriculum Coordinator.
- Staggered 3-year cycle for parents and citizens, 1-year role for Subject Area Chairs
