From Principal Shawn Bromeland:

Following the Governor's announcement that distance learning will continue for the rest of the school year, reflecting on the number of changes we have experienced in the last month is incredible. The process of revamping a decades-old system of education has been exhilarating, frustrating, and humbling all at the same time. I know it's not easy for families, and there are several aspects to the changes that aren't perfect. Please know that our number one priority in all of this is the safety and education of our students.

I am so proud of the teachers and staff at Eagle Point, who have been outstanding in their dedication and commitment to ensuring that each and every student has the potential to be their best and flourish academically even in a rapidly changing world. We miss seeing the happy faces of our students like you wouldn't believe!

As we now continue our distance learning, there are a few things to remember. We are still required by law to track attendance for students. We will be calling if we haven't heard from you or can see that your student isn't logging in for the online lessons. If your student needs a sick day, or you won't be logging in for any reason, please let your student's teacher know directly, or leave a message on our attendance line at 651-702-8302.

If you need help with the homework, or if you have technology concerns, please keep communicating with your teachers. If you are worried about the impact of these changes on your kids, or perhaps feel the stress as a parent, I strongly encourage you to reach out to your teacher, our Social Worker Megan David, or to call or email me directly. We know this isn't easy, and there are several resources available to help. You deserve the support, and should not feel guilty or worried about reaching out to see what might be available.

We have two staff development days coming up this Friday, May 1st and on Monday, May 4th. There will be no "school" on those days. The next round of homework delivery on school bus routes is scheduled for Wednesday, May 6th, and homework pick up at school will be on Thursday, May 7th. There are multiple Eagle Point Parent Group Board Member opportunities for the upcoming 2020 - 2021 school year. This year, the Chair & Secretary positions are up for election in May for a July 1, 2020 start of a 2-year term. Also, we have an opening for the Treasurer position due to a retirement. The Treasurer position is a 1-year interim term to maintain the 2-year cycle of board member replacement. An overview of the different positions is below:

Chair – presides over the meetings & develops the agenda and yearly schedule. Has oversight of ad hoc committees and events. Main spokesperson of the group and liaison with the school.

Secretary – handles communications, emails, social media, and meeting minutes. They are the record keeper of the organization.

Treasurer – maintains financial record keeping, pays expenses, and handles event deposits. Develops the annual budget and is responsible for financial management of the group.
