Student Drop off and Pick up Procedures for Hybrid Learners

Morning Drop Off – If you are dropping your student off at school in the morning, please pull up to the front of the school. IMPORTANT – drive all the way up to the flagpole. Do not let your student out of the car early. Do not stop and get out of the car with your student. If you need to walk in with your student, please park in a parking spot. No parking in the drop off line.

Drop off begins at 8:40 am. Please do not drop off your students any earlier than 8:40 am. Students eating breakfast at school can come in at 8:40 am. Students who are not eating breakfast will come in at 8:45 am. School starts at 8:50 am.

Afternoon Pick Up – The school day ends at 12:50 pm. If you are picking your student up after school, please park at Hope Church. You will need to get out of your car and line up on the blue spots marked on the sidewalk. You will need to stay outside, and we will call the students out to meet you. Please do not come into the building, we will send the kids to you.

The parking lot of Eagle Point is reserved for Special Education buses and daycare buses at the end of the day. PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN THE EAGLE POINT PARKING LOT TO PICK UP YOUR STUDENT. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
