Family/Teacher conferences are coming up quickly! Please be aware, the dates of conferences have been moved back one week from what was originally published. Conference dates are Monday, Oct. 26th through Thursday, October 29th, We will have school on Friday, October 23, and there will be no school on Wednesday, October 28th.

This year we are excited to introduce electronic conference scheduling through a website called PTCfast.com. This site will allow you to reserve a conference time for all of your students at Eagle Point at times that work best for you.

In an effort to reduce the people in our building and provide time for cleaning each day, conferences will be held via Zoom. If your student is a Hybrid learner, you should sign up for a conference with your child's Hybrid teacher. If your student is a Distance learner, please sign up for a conference with their Distance learning teacher.

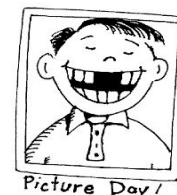

Student Drop off and Pick up Procedures for Hybrid Learners

Morning Drop Off – If you are dropping your student off at school in the morning, please pull up to the front of the school. **IMPORTANT** – drive all the way up to the flagpole. If you need to walk in with your student, please park in a parking spot. No parking in the drop off line.

Drop off begins at 8:40 am. Students eating breakfast at school come in at 8:40 am. Students not eating breakfast will come in at 8:45 am. School starts at 8:50 am.

Afternoon Pick Up – **PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN THE EAGLE POINT PARKING LOT TO PICK UP YOUR STUDENT.** The school day ends at 12:50 pm. If you are picking your student up after school, please park at Hope Church. The parking lot of Eagle Point is reserved for Special Education buses and daycare buses at the end of the day.

COVID-19 Daily Screening Tool

Families should screen each child daily before leaving for school

If your child has:

One of the following:

fever (100.4 or higher), new-onset and/or worsening cough, difficulty breathing, new loss of taste or smell*

OR

Two or more of the following:

sore throat, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, chills, muscle pain, excessive fatigue, severe headache, new-onset runny/stuffy nose

**Keep your child home and notify your school nurse.
Siblings and household contacts should also stay home.**

***If you don't have a thermometer, notify your school nurse
and they will check your child's temperature upon arrival.**
