From Principal Shawn Bromeland:

Hello EP families! The building has felt so full of life the past few weeks as students returned and school feels more “normal”. I want to take this opportunity to share some information that may be helpful as we continue to welcome students and families back to school.

One of the questions we have received is what students will do if they are required to temporarily switch to distance learning due to COVID. If that should happen, your child will receive a Zoom link to join a distance learning teacher’s class. This will allow them to sit in and participate in math and reading lessons, similar to when they were in distance learning earlier this year. The big difference is that your child’s regular classroom teacher will send assignments via Seesaw to your student and check on school work. They will still have their in person teacher, they will just be in the distance class for math and reading lessons.

Also, we are looking to hire a Playground/Lunchroom Monitor to help for about 2 hours every day during our lunch and recess times. If you are interested or know anyone who may be, please email Christine Kass at ckass@isd622.org.

Finally, conferences are coming up soon. You will be getting a link to sign up for a conference time, which will be held over Zoom again like in the fall. Please connect with us if you have any questions.

Indoor Recess Guidelines

If the air temp is below zero, or the wind chill is -10, students will stay inside for recess. Otherwise, per guidelines from the National Weather Service, it is safe for students to be outside for their 15-20 minute recess time.

For example, if it's 1 above, and the wind chill is -9, we go outside. If it's 1 above and the wind chill is -11, we stay inside.

We do expect students to be prepared to go outside for recess every day, and bring everything needed to stay warm outside in case we do go out. This includes a coat, hat, gloves, snow pants, and boots. If you don't want your student to go outside, we must have a note from their doctor in order to make the accommodation. Thank you for your understanding.
